The Basic Sail Training Program course of instruction is based on a local Naval Station Newport, Morale Welfare & Recreation Department, Keelboat Qualification. No special qualifications or memberships (i.e. US Sailing Association or US Naval Sailing Association) are required of volunteer instructors.

The pay isn't good (because there is none) but the personal satisfaction is tremendous. MWR does provide 'Sail Training Credits' ... you'll receive credit for every 2 hours of training. You can use these credits (up to 50% of your rental fee) when you check-out a recreational boat for your personal sailing pleasure.
