

5. SCHEDULE: The regatta is divided into two one-design classes, Rhodes 19 and Shields to optimize racing. All boats will rendezvous West of Coasters Harbor Island in the vicinity of R14 (Bishop's Rock). Each race course and the number of races will be determined by the Race Committee based on weather conditions. It is the intent of the organizing authority to conduct a minimum of three races.

6. REGISTRATION

- 6.1. The official entry form shall be used. A check payable to CHNYC should accompany the entry form.
 - 6.2. Competitors may pre-register by completing the entry form and mailing it to the CHNYC postmarked by 2 August.
 - 6.3. Competitors may pre-register with the appropriate Fleet Captains or Regatta Chairman by 4 August. Entry forms and fees received after 4 August may incur a late fee of \$10.
 - 6.4. Competitors sailing Navy-owned boats will be assigned boats by the appropriate Fleet Captain. No rotations are planned once boat assignments are made for the duration of the regatta.
7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS – Sailing Instructions will be posted on the CHNYC WEB site in draft form by 15 July 2004 and will available in final form on 5 August 2004.

8. SCORING: The RRS Appendix A, using the Low Point System will be used except as modified below:

- 8.1. At least five boats must start to be scored. Three races constitute a series; unless fewer races are held. If more than three races are held, one throw out will be allowed.
- 8.2. Because the scoring system provides for excluding one or more scores from the series score, the score for a breach of Rule 2, *Fair Sailing*, and RRS Part 4, *Other Requirements When Racing*, shall not be excluded. The next-worse score shall be excluded. (RRS 88.3)
- 8.3. Ties will be handled under RRS Appendix A, Scoring; Rules A8 and A9,

9. PRIZES

- 9.1. For both classes, prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places at the CHNYC cookout/awards ceremony across from the Officer's Club at Naval Station, Newport, RI.

10. SAFETY & SECURITY INFORMATION

- 10.1. Races may be cancelled, postponed, or abandoned by the Race Committee due to weather conditions or other safety concerns.
- 10.2. A boat retiring from a race shall notify a Race Committee vessel before leaving the course, or, when that is impossible, the Marina Office immediately after arrival ashore.
- 10.3. Competitors are reminded that Narragansett Bay is a restricted channel and sailing vessels do not have right-of-way over a vessel which may be restricted in her ability to maneuver.
- 10.4. Naval Station Newport has established a restricted area in the navigable waters adjacent to and surrounding Coasters Harbor Island. Additionally, an exclusion area is established in Coddington Cove. Vessels approaching or entering these areas may be hailed, stopped or boarded by law enforcement or military vessels. These security measures will not be grounds for redress under RRS 62.
