









# Race Signals

The meanings of visual and sound signals are stated below. An arrow pointing up or down (↑ ↓) means that a visual signal is displayed or removed. A dot (•) means a sound; dots with dashes (• - - - •) mean repetitive sounds. When a visual signal is displayed over a class flag, the signal applies only to that class.


## Postponement Signals




The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal unless at that time the race is <i>abandoned</i> again or <i>postponed</i>.</p>	 ↑ •••	<p><b>N over H</b> All races are <i>abandoned</i>. Further signals ashore.</p>	 ↑ •••	<p><b>N over A</b> All races are <i>abandoned</i>. No more racing today.</p>




## Recall Signals

 ↑ ••	<p><b>S</b> No later than the warning signal: Sail the short course. At a rounding or finishing <i>mark</i>: <i>Finish</i> between the nearby <i>mark</i> and the staff displaying this flag.</p>	 • - - - •	<p><b>C</b> The position of the next <i>mark</i> has been changed.</p>

 ↑ •	<p><b>L</b> Ashore: A notice to competitors has been posted. Afloat: Come within hail or follow this boat.</p>	 • - - - •	<p><b>M</b> The object displaying this signal replaces a missing <i>mark</i>.</p>	 ↑ •	<p><b>Y</b> Wear personal buoyancy.</p>	 (no sound)	<p><b>Blue flag</b> or shape. This race committee boat is in position at the finishing line.</p>
